

Knowledge, Experiences and Attitudes concerning Genetics among Retinoblastoma Survivors and Parents

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Retinoblastoma is a childhood eye cancer caused by mutation in the *RB1* gene. Researchers conducted focus group discussions with survivors of retinoblastoma and parents of kids with retinoblastoma, to uncover what they understand about retinoblastoma genetics and heritability, how they have experienced it in their day-to-day lives, and what their views are on what the associated risk means for them.
